So Katie Holmes thinks she can dance - and in a few weeks, she'll display her moves before a discriminating audience, The Associated Press reports.

Nigel Lythgoe, who is the producer of Fox's "So You Think You Can Dance," announced on Wednesday night's show that the 30-year-old actress will perform for the reality contest's 100th episode, airing July 23.

Holmes will pay homage to Judy Garland. In a taped number, she'll sing and dance to the Garland classic "Get Happy." The actress' TV cameo is meant to promote the new foundation she launched with Lythgoe and "Dancing With the Stars" judge Carrie Ann Inaba.

The nonprofit, called **Dizzy Feet**, aims to support dance education and programs, and talented dancers who can't afford training.

"I think it's important for children to experience music and dance," Holmes said. "Every child should have the opportunity to discover what it is they like and have access to the very best in that pursuit."

This isn't the first time Tom Cruise's better half has put her best foot forward in prime time.

In October, Holmes donned a skintight unitard and long black gloves for a steamy song and dance on the ABC drama "Eli Stone."
